10:15 PANEL 2: EUROPEAN POLICY SCENE
WHAT POLICY OPTIONS ARE CURRENTLY BEING DEBATED IN EUROPE?

Given the EU's 'Green Deal' and the broader context of the recent shift in US policy on climate change, this Panel will briefly review the record of Market Based Measures such as emissions trading systems (ETSs), ticket taxes, and environmentally determined airport charges in reducing European aviation's climate footprint to date. The panel will discuss what might be the best future approaches; for example should there be a stronger aviation ETS? What elements should be included in an aviation ETS? What role will IATA's CORSIA play in Europe? What is the current thinking on fuel taxation? The panel will also consider the role of command and control measures such as national CO₂ caps or mandated use of sustainable aviation fuels.
