Frankfurt Air Cargo Exchange is intended to be a forum for academics in air cargo. The importance of research in air cargo is increasing with the challenges in the market, including a push for digitalization, workforce demographics, political instability, sustainability objectives and many others.

We invite presentations in the domain of air cargo across the entire spectrum of potential methodologies. Frankfurt ACX fosters the active exchange and networking among (junior) researchers via active discussion.

There are two presentation formats:

- Full presentation including feedback from a discussant: Please submit an extended abstract of about 750 words. The abstract should state the objective of the research and its contribution, methodology, and initial results. Participants are requested to submit a draft version of their paper two weeks prior to the colloquium to allow for a discussant to comment on their presentation.
- Research pitch: Please submit an extended abstract of about 400 words. It should state the objective of the research, expected contribution and initial results. This format is intended to introduce early-phase research and discuss it with the audience.

Frankfurt ACX cordially invites industry experts to join the academic discussions at the workshop. We will close the day with a panel session of industry experts in air cargo to mirror the academic presentation with industry spotlights.
